Today we started the first day of a four day curriculum on Internet Safety. The goal of this curriculum is to build on what the students heard about in the presentation I gave them last spring. Over the next 4 days, the students will take a closer look at 4 different aspects of internet safety. They will work in small groups to analyze situations, discuss these, and develop ideas for positive online behavior. These topics include:

- 1. Cyberbullying
- 2. Appropriate online behavior
- 3. Overexposure
- 4. Online Predators & Sexting

After each class, a summary of the material covered will be sent to you. The goal is to promote productive conversation between parents and students on this topic. These concepts need to be continually reinforced to the students over many conversations in order for them to truly understand what is appropriate online behavior.
