

WALKING PRIVILEGES PERMISSION FORM

Dear Form IV–VI Parents:

By tradition, the school permits members of Forms IV–VI to leave the school building for lunch (Form IV) and for Forms V and VI during free periods, i.e. those periods between 8:28 a.m. and 3:11 p.m. when a student is not scheduled for classes, activities or conferences. The only exception is that students on athletic teams must attend their PE study halls.

For the first semester, Form IV will only have lunch Walking Privileges. In the second semester, those privileges will expand to include the students' free periods, other than PE study halls.

The school has always regarded this permission as a privilege, which students are expected to exercise with discretion. It is in no way intended to discourage them from using the school's facilities to full advantage. If you wish your son to have this privilege, please sign the permission slip below and have him return it to Ms. McDermott, the Division Head Assistant, as soon as possible.
